



Recreational Cabins



Willow Lake Recreation Area near Woodbine, Iowa

Scotch Pine Cabin ~ \$132 per night, \$792 full week (7 consecutive nights)



Open year round. Four room facility with covered deck, two bedrooms with queen beds, ADA bathroom with tub and shower, kitchen/stove/oven/refrigerator/microwave/toaster/coffee maker, pans and large utensils, TV/VCR/DVD, heat/air conditioning, charcoal grill and fire ring, loft with four single beds and two futons that convert to double beds, and sleeps up to 12.

White Pine Cabin ~ \$100 per night, \$600 full week (7 consecutive nights)



Open year round. Four room facility with covered deck, two bedrooms with full size beds with single bunk beds attached, ADA bathroom with shower, kitchen/stove/oven/refrigerator/microwave/toaster/coffee maker, pans and large utensils, TV/VCR/DVD, heat/air conditioning, charcoal grill and fire ring, futon that converts to double bed, and sleeps up to 8.

Housekeeping Cabins

These two cabins are located close together, secluded and private amongst the pine trees, offering a great place for family reunions or other large gatherings.

2 night minimum for Friday & Saturday during peak season
3 night minimum for Memorial Day, 4th of July, and Labor Day
\$100 cleaning/damage deposit is required

Please Bring

Sleeping bags/bedding/pillows, towels and extra blankets, table service, dish soap/dish towels/pot holders, flashlight, trash bags, charcoal, movies, and extra lawn chairs.

Camping Cabins ~ \$50 per night, \$300 full week (7 consecutive nights)



Open April 1st-December 31st. Red Oak, Hemlock, and Black Walnut cabins are located on a hill overlooking Willow Lake. One room facility with covered deck, heat/air conditioning, microwave and small refrigerator, modern showers and flush toilets located in campground (Open April 1st-October 31st), unisex latrine, campfire ring and no-freeze hydrant, full size bed, futon that converts to double bed, set of single bunk beds, and sleeps up to 6.

Camping Cabins

2 night minimum for Friday & Saturday during peak season
3 night minimum for Memorial Day, 4th of July, and Labor Day

Please Bring

Sleeping bags/bedding/pillows, towels and extra blankets, table service, tub to wash dishes/dish soap/dish towels/pot holders, flashlight, trash bags, charcoal, coffee maker, cookware, outdoor cooking stove, and lawn chairs.

**Firewood available for purchase from HCCB or bring your own
To protect against the spread of Emerald Ash Borer in Iowa,
please do not bring any out-of-state firewood**

Cabins may be reserved up to 12 months in advance. Full payment is required when reservation is made. Payment is only accepted with a credit card including MasterCard, Visa, or Discover. Reservations are taken on a first come, first served basis.

Cabin Rules & Regulations

- **Smoking is prohibited in the cabins**
- Quiet hours are 10:30 p.m.-6:00 a.m.
- Non-registered guests must leave by 10:30 p.m.
- Responsible party of record will be held responsible for any damages or theft that occurs
- **No keg beer allowed in the cabins**
- **Pets are not allowed in or near the cabins**
- No one under the age of 21 is allowed to occupy a cabin unless that minor is accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, 21 years or older
- Maximum number of occupants per cabin
 - Scotch Pine—12
 - White Pine—8
 - Red Oak, Hemlock, & Black Walnut—6
- No camping trailers or tents may be at the cabins; please use the campground
- Park Rangers are given authority to refuse rental privileges and rescind any and all rental permits for cause
- All Park Rules & Regulations of the Harrison County Conservation Board are in effect

Directions to Cabins

The Willow Lake Recreation Area is located 6 miles west of Woodbine, Iowa. From I-29, take Highway 30 North and continue to Woodbine. Turn left onto F20L (Easton Trail) and follow the signs. To get to the camping cabins, take the main entrance to the park. The housekeeping cabins are located on the west side of the lake.
